#### Creationtide

All schools will be emailed a request to complete their Annual Return. There are 3 forms to complete - school office / clerk to governors / headteacher, chair and ex officio foundation governor.

#### Admissions Policies – For all VA schools & Academies

Your Admissions Policy must be reviewed each year with a full consultation at least every 7 years. Please refer to the checklist that was recently emailed out to you & review the guidance documentation on our website which explains all that you need to know.

If your school is an academy in a MAT, please liaise with your central team to check arrangements.

#### **Foundation Governor Nominations**

Please ask your clerk to review the terms of office for your foundation governors. If there are any which are due to expire before spring 2026, you will need to prepare and submit nominations forms along with a reference from the incumbent.


#### Climate Action - Book Launch
