





40acts - The 40-day Lent Generosity Challenge from Stewardship

They do have a dedicated child/school resources as well. These do not seem to have been updated so if you have used before then it might not be of use.

This is the 40acts Together Firstly, you'll need someone to co-ordinate the project.

Presumably, since you're reading this, that's you! The idea is simple – during the period of Lent, as a whole school, you give something back, not give something up. Please assure your staff that this project does not necessarily have to be religiously focused, unless of course that is appropriate for your school. 40acts is simply a way to encourage staff and pupils to be more outward-focused and generous in their community. The full kids wall chart is printable for each child to take home and be involved with the 40acts Individual challenge too. Make sure that you download the event planner for schools too so that your children can join the wider generosity movement and put on a celebration for their parents.


Advent 2025: A Free Collective Worship Resource

Each week includes:

A suggested Liturgical Greeting, An 'I wonder' activity, A Bible passage activity, A video explanation, Reflective and practical actions, A couple of prayers, Liturgical Ending

Las Posadas




- Welcome Mary & Joseph to stay at your place | The Church of England
- Ideas around the Mexican Posada Posada' (Spanish for 'inn') is a Christmas activity which lasts from December $16^{th} 24^{th}$ when small versions of Mary and Joseph travel around different households in the community and stay there for one night.
- Have some figures of Mary and Joseph and a donkey in a suitcase and have them travel from class to class. Include the Christmas story and maybe a book to record how they are welcomed into the class.
- Or maybe have a class storybag that could go home each night with a different child to share the story.
- Idea from Jennie that the children in their KS1 class sign up and take the bag home and the last family bring them to the church service where a stable is set up. Families take photos which are then shared so that the journey can be followed.

Eco Advent



- Diocese of Bath and Wells have created an online Eco Advent calendar which has a daily activity with a video and prayer.
- Eco Advent Bath and Wells Diocese
- It is aimed for use at church and home but there may be some useful ideas.
- Zero Waste Advent Have a jar and get the pupils to come up with ideas for each day that you are in school to do with helping/exploring nature/preparing for Christmas

Reverse Advent Calendars etc...



- Have a box in each classroom or as a school or in the staffroom and encourage pupils/staff to bring something in for a foodbank. Try and add something in each day.
- Send home a brown bag for each family and ask for donations for your local foodbank.
- Idea around having a reverse box and the list of items required sent out then hampers for school food bank or local food bank are made.

Advent Reading for you



O Come Emmanuel Reflections on the Advent Antiphons by David Hoyle, Esther Prior, Philip North -

<u>Paperback / softback – 9781781405192</u> This beautifully illustrated, full-colour daily Advent companion explores the ancient biblical names and images for the coming Messiah familiar to most people from the hymn, 'O come, O come Emmanuel'.

Well-known writers offer a total of twenty-four reflections, one for each weekday of the four weeks of Advent. The writers each offer three reflections on one of the seven antiphons: O Wisdom, O Adonai, O Root of Jesse, O Key of David, O Morning Star, O King of the Nations, O Emmanuel. Lastly, there are three reflections on the Magnificat – Mary's Song – which the antiphons have been heard alongside since at least the eighth century.

• <u>Women of the Nativity An Advent and Christmas Journey in Nine Stories by Paula Gooder - Paperback / softback – 9781781404607</u> The story is told from the perspective of nine women in all including Mary, Elizabeth, Rachel, and others whom scripture records or tradition has imagined, such as the innkeeper's wife. As we hear the familiar stories afresh through their words, the wonder of the incarnation and its consequences for good and for ill, come to vivid life in a new way.
