### Admissions Policy

A reminder that your Admissions Authority body must meet to formally determine your policy for 2027/28 admissions by **28 February**. For VA schools the Admissions Authority is the governing body, for academies, it is the MAT and for VC schools it is the LA. **The policy must then be published on your website by 15 March.** VA schools should also email a copy of the policy to us.

For clarity, from 15 March, your school website must show 3 policies – current year, 2026/27 and 2027/28. See our website for guidance [HERE](#).
