Introduction

Our programme of events is designed to support church schools in realising their distinctively Christian vision. Living out the values of **generous faith, courageous hope and life-giving love**, the DBE will support our diocesan family of schools to offer:

- life-giving, life-changing learning through excellent education, shaped by a distinctively Christ-like vision and ethos
- inclusive and inspirational Collective Worship, inviting all to grow in faith
- excellent Religious Education (RE), enabling children and young people to reflect critically and explore faith, belief, and Christian responses to life's big questions
- hospitality, hope and love to children, young people and households
- a sense of belonging to those of all faiths and none, building community near and far, local and global

This is our core purpose; it is why we exist – everything we do will fit with this.

We have aimed to structure our support through a pathway of careers within a school namely:

- Early Career Teachers
- Teachers
- Support Staff
- RE & Collective Worship Leaders
- New Headteachers
- Serving Headteachers
- Executive Headteachers
- Governors & Clergy

Some events will combine people from different areas of the school workforce as we believe that powerful learning can take place between different staff members. We would like to note that although we separate the training into different areas of the school workforce, this does not exclude someone from a different area of the school staff to attend. For example, an RE lead might offer the RE lead training to a teacher they work with as part of their ongoing CPD. It can be flexible to meet the needs of your school as they do all run differently.

Fees

Unless otherwise stated fees are per participant. The lower price listed is for schools who sign up to the DBE Partnership Agreement (PA). Where one fee is quoted it is fixed for any school.

Venues

We offer a mix of online and face-to-face events. Sometimes we ask schools to host a networking meeting; if this is the case, we liaise directly with the relevant networking group. If the event is at Church House, Derby you will be asked for your car registration if you would like to park there. Derby Cathedral organise parking and your registration will be put onto the system to grant you free parking for the session.

Terms and Conditions

The DBE require at least 10 working days' notice of a cancellation. Refunds may only be possible in exceptional circumstances. Before cancelling, always consider whether another person could benefit from attending the event.

Where the course comprises several parts, the price is for all sessions. Unless indicated otherwise, the same participant is expected to attend all the sessions and the school will therefore be invoiced for ALL sessions.

Invoices are usually issued 1 week before the event is scheduled to take place. We respectfully request payment within 30 days of the date of the invoice.

Headteachers' Conference will be invoiced at the end of April. We respectfully request payment within 30 days of the date of the invoice.

The DBE reserve the right to cancel any event should there be insufficient bookings to make the event viable. Where this is the case, applicants will be notified and refunded any fees paid.

None of our schools can achieve this on their own. We are a family of church schools and partnership is a fundamental principle. Partnership takes many forms including relationships with other church and community schools, local clergy, church community and the wider diocese through the DBE.

Derby DBE receives no public money. It is reliant on income from investments (closed church schools) and from the wider diocesan budget (ultimately from the voluntary giving of churchgoers). By signing up, your school is making an important contribution to our partnership. Each school is a valued part of the Diocese of Derby and so the DBE is committed to support each valued, family member. Early Career Teachers

This programme is essential for all new teachers, whether starting a teaching career in a church school or community school. The recent OFSTED RE research report and the ECT framework are clear on the essential nature of subject knowledge CPD. RE is often a subject that teachers feel less confident teaching and this programme of CPD will improve both RE subject knowledge and confidence.

Timings have been carefully considered to try and allow staff to travel home for the virtual sessions. If possible, we politely request that staff are allowed to leave slightly earlier on this day to allow them to access the training at home.

If you have attended these sessions previously, it will still be relevant to access the sessions below this academic year.
